SECTION 3: HAZARDOUS POSSIBILITIES

Harmful. Dangerous for the environment. Highly flammable. Injuries to health: can cause lung damage when swallowing. Irritating to respiratory system and skin. Toxic to aquatic organisms, may cause long-term adverse effects in the aquatic environment.

SECTION 4: FIRST AID MEASURES

In case of accident or if you feel unwell:

First aid measures / Inhalation:

Ensure supply of fresh air and seek medical advice.

Remove soiled or soaked clothing immediately. Do not allow drying. Clean body thoroughly (bath, shower). In case of contact with skin wash off immediately with soap and water /or Vaseline pharmaceutical grade/.

First aid measures / eye contact:

In case of contact with eyes rinse thoroughly with plenty of water and seek medical advice.

First aid measures / ingestion:

Induce the patient to vomit of his/her own accord, only if fully conscious. When swallowed accidentally, do not induce vomiting, get medical help. When swallowed seek medical aid immediately and show the physician the packaging or the label of the packaging.

SECTION 5: FIRE FIGHTING MEASURES

Use suitable extinguisher. Foam, dry powder, carbon dioxide. Extinguishing media that must not be used for safety reasons is water or full water jet. Special exposure hazards arising from the substance or preparation itself, its combustion products or from resulting gases. Combustion gases of organic materials must in principle be graded as inhalation poisons. Special protective equipment for firefighting must be used. Do not inhale combustion gases. In case of combustion use suitable breathing apparatus.

SECTION 6: ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Personal precautions:

Ensure adequate ventilation. Remove persons to safety. Keep people away and stay on the upwind side.

Environmental precautions / Handling and storage:

Do not allow to enter drains or waterways. Do not allow spilt product to enter soil or waterways. Take up with absorbent material (eg sand, kieselguhr, and sawdust). Pick up in containers capable of being locked. Clean contaminated floors and objects thoroughly with water and detergents, observing environmental regulations. Dispose of as prescribed. Clean equipment with solvents/gasoline, acetone/.

SECTION 7: HANDLING AND STORAGE

7.1 The product is in 5 l. packs.

If the product is in 5 l. packs more than 5 l and will be used for prepacking in the small 20 ml. packs good ventilation and neutralisation of vapours are essential. Avoid impact, friction and electro-static loading; risk of ignition. Use antistatic tools. Keep away from sources of ignition. Use explosion-proof equipment/fittings and non-sparking tools. Requirements for storage rooms and vessels. Storage rooms must be properly ventilated.

Recommended storage temperature: 10-25°C. The storage temperature should not exceed 50 °C.

Keep away from sources of ignition, water and alkalis. Keep in a cool place away from acids, alkalis and combustible material. Do not store or transport together with foodstuffs. Keep container tightly closed; open and handle with care.

7.2 The product is in 20 ml. packs.

In this case there are not necessary special conditions for ventilation/tools./see 7.1

SECTION 8: LIMITED EXPOSURE / PERSONAL PROTECTION EQUIPMENT FOR PERSONNEL.

8.1 Dgambo packs 5 l. minimum

Respiratory protection:

When the product is packed in 20 ml. packs from 5 l. packs and ventilation is insufficient, use a respiratory protection apparatus. In case of dust formation, use a fine dust facemask.

Hand protection:

Gloves (solvent-proof). Not suitable: synthetic rubber gloves.

Eye protection:

Wear facemasks when handling large quantities. Safety glasses, or face shield if necessary.

Do not inhale vapours or dust. Avoid frequent or prolonged contact with skin. Avoid contact with eyes. It is essential for pregnant women to avoid inhaling the product and not to let it come in contact with the skin.
