Storage and Application

The product should be protected against direct sunlight and extremes in temperature and humidity and stored upright in its original packaging.

- The film should be applied within a 12 month period from the delivery date.
- The film should be removed within 6 months from the date of lamination:
 - within 3 months for carpet
 - within 6 months for all other surfaces if the product has been exposed outdoor
- Surface preparation is important. The substrate should be clean and free from residue, such as dust and oil, when the tape is applied in order to achieve optimum adhesion.
- Do not press too hard when applying. This may cause the end of the tape to peel.
- If applying to surfaces treated with machining oil, degrease the surface carefully. Any remains will be a cause for surface contamination or adhesive residue.
